Thank you for participating in our recent campaigns to submit comments to the Environmental Protection Agency on proposals related to treated seed, livestock air emissions and pesticide labeling.

In total, 891 comments were submitted:

- 322 comments on regulations governing the labeling and handling of seeds treated with pesticides,
- 297 comments on the agency’s reconsideration of current air emission reporting exemptions for livestock farms, and
- 272 comments on streamlining how pesticide label information is collected, structured, reviewed and published.
